Position of clock hands based on climate change and threat of nuclear war.





## Threats and Vested Interests Responsible

Threat	Principal vested interests
Environmental, incl. climate change	Fossil fuel, nuclear, aluminium, steel, forestry, agriculture industries
Social injustice & oppression	Big business; rich individuals; financial services & property industries; autocratic governments; gov'ts of the Global North;
All war	Armaments industry; military industrial complex; powerful nation-states grabbing land & other resources
Nuclear war	As for All War + nuclear energy industry
All threats	Economic system, with ideologies of endless growth, leave it to the market, trickle-down wealth, money-based values

- Subversion, assassination, threats, invasion


## The Need for a Stronger Social Change Movement
